COMMENTS from the Public: Mr. John Knapp, Superintendent of Mogadore Local Schools; thanked the village and council for understanding the cancelling of the high school homecoming football game on short notice due to unfortunate circumstances. He also reminded everyone of the craft sale that will be held on Saturday, October 7.

June Long, 4061 Etter Rd, representing the Cemetery Board; stated that the cemetery walk-thru was held October, 2. She said the members thought the cemetery looks good. They are looking for long-term goals for the cemetery and would appreciate ideas, time and money from council to maintain the cemetery. The cemetery board meeting will be held on Monday, October 9 and one item that will be discussed is planting shrubs facing Gilchrist Road.

Scott Varney, Clerk-Treasurer, distributed his recommendation to the Portage County Budget Commission. If Portage County agrees to his recommendation, the village would receive a substantial increase of funding.
