

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2017-69, BY ATTACHING AND INCORPORATING THE CORRECTED EXHIBIT A WHICH OUTLINES THE 2017 REVISED ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, During the Village Council Meeting December 6, 2017, Council passed Ordinance No. 2017-69, which amended the annual appropriations for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2017-69 referenced Exhibit A, which outlined the total revised appropriations for the Village for fiscal year ending December 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Subsequent to the passage of said Ordinance, it was discovered that Exhibit A was incorrect and did not accurately reflect the information described within the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, The corrected Exhibit A has been forwarded to all necessary parties and this amended ordinance is necessary only to make said corrections to the Village's records; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION ONE: Ordinance 2017-69 is hereby amended to incorporate the corrected Exhibit A, which outlines the total revised appropriations for the Village for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2017. Said Exhibit is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION TWO: The Village of Mogadore finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to provide for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the residents of the Village and for the purpose of making corrections to Ordinance 2017-69, provided this legislation receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
