Ordinance No. 2018-56Passed July 5, 2018

SPONSOR: FINANCE COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF A NEWLY TYPED VILLAGE CHARTER INCLUDING CORRECTIONS TO MATTERS OF FORM AND CHANGES RESOLVING INCONSISTENCY BUT NOT CHANGES TO MATTERS OF SUBSTANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the current Charter provides that the Charter Review Commission must review the Charter every four (4) years; and,

WHEREAS, the Charter Review Commission has reviewed the Charter and presented the Village Council with recommendations; and,

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Mogadore, upon recommendation of the Charter Review Commission, has determined that the Charter needs to be corrected for typographical and grammatical errors; and,

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Mogadore, upon recommendation of the Charter Review Commission, has determined that the electorate has abolished the elected office of Clerk-Treasurer and replaced it with the appointed office of Clerk-Treasurer; and,

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Mogadore, upon recommendation of the Charter Review Commission, has determined that other portions of the Charter is inconsistent with respect to the new appointed position of Clerk-Treasurer; and,

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Mogadore may, without a vote of the electorate, correct typographical and grammatical errors within the Charter, and may make corrective changes to resolve inconsistencies therein with respect to offices created or abolished by vote of the electorate; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The version of the Charter of the Village of Mogadore, attached hereto as Exhibit A, is adopted as the Charter of the Village of Mogadore.

SECTION 2: The version of the Charter of the Village of Mogadore, attached hereto, does not contain any substantive changes except to resolve inconsistencies and typographical errors in order to follow the intent of the voters.

SECTION 3: That the aforesaid recitals are incorporated herein and rendered findings of this Council.
