Ordinance No. 2018-58Passed August 1, 2018

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ADORNI'S SERVICE CENTER REGARDING LEASING OF TWO PARKING SPOTS ALONG WITH THE ESTABLISHMENT OF \$40 ADMINISTRATIVE FEE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor of the Village of Mogadore is hereby authorized to promptly enter into an agreement with Adorni's Service Center regarding leasing of two parking spots along with establishment of \$40 administrative fee. The agreement shall be in a form substantially similar to the one attached as Exhibit "A" hereto.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to sign all necessary paperwork to effectuate the entering of, execution and implementation of said agreement.

SECTION 3: That, to the extent not already done so, the funds required for the payment of the obligations incurred are hereby appropriated for the purposes described.

SECTION 4: Establishing new C.O. Section 70.13, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and incorporated herein.

SECTION 5: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Village residents, to allow for the timely submission of the approved Agreement within guidelines and requirements, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Administration and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
