

RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 2018-67

Passed August 22, 2018

SECTION 5: The Clerk-Treasurer shall deliver a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Summit County Fiscal Officer within five (5) days after its passage.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the Village of Mogadore and the inhabitants thereof and for the further reason that the property owner(s) who is responsible for the charges has failed to respond to billing notices, and to ensure the timely submission of this assessment to the proper authority; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least five of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
