RESOLUTION AND ORDER ACCEPTING THE BID AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK- TREASURER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR PURCHASE OF BATTERY OPERATED RESCUE TOOLS AND SUPPORTING EQUIPMENT FOR THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has this day accepted the bid from Howell Rescue Systems for the purchase of battery operated rescue tools and supporting equipment for the Village of Mogadore Fire Department, which was found to be necessary and advertised for bid pursuant to Resolution No. 2018-14.

WHEREAS, said bid was the lowest responsive and responsible bid for the purchase at \$30,803.00.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for purchase with Howell Rescue Systems in the amount of \$30,803.00 for the purchase of battery operated rescue tools and supporting equipment for the Village of Mogadore Fire Department.

SECTION 2: The Village of Mogadore finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure found necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the residents of the Village of Mogadore and furthermore for the purchase of battery operated rescue tools and supporting equipment for the Village of Mogadore Fire Department and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor or at the earliest period allowed by law.
