

RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Resolution
Ordinance No. 2018-55

Passed July 5, 2018

Failure of the Mayor or Council to make selections as provided herein shall authorize the Mayor to select such members as Council failed to select, and/or Council, by majority vote, to select such members as the Mayor failed to select, as the case may be.

If both the Mayor and the Council fail to meet the February closing date then the Council, by majority vote, will select all eight (8) members of the Charter Review Commission before March 30 of the year in which the Commission is to meet.

Upon selection of the eight member Commission, the alternate member shall be designated. Designation of the alternate member shall be made by voluntary nomination or by a lottery.

Within five (5) calendar months after such appointment, the Charter Review Commission shall recommend to the Council such revisions or additions to the Charter, as in its judgment are desirable. The Council must submit to the electors not later than the next succeeding general election any such proposed alterations, revisions or amendments, unless rejected by a three-fourths (3/4) vote of the members of Council for each proposed amendment.

SECTION 2: The proposed amendment to Section 18.01 of the Charter of the Village of Mogadore shall be placed before the qualified electors of the Village of Mogadore for their approval on the ballot of the November 6, 2018 election.

SECTION 3: The Village Council of Mogadore requests the following ballot language:

“Shall Section 18.01 of the Charter of the Village of Mogadore be amended, effective January 1, 2019, to require that a Charter Review Commission be empaneled every seven (7) years beginning in 2025?”

 FOR THE AMENDMENT AGAINST THE AMENDMENT

SECTION 4: The Clerk-Treasurer shall certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections, along with a copy of the proposed ballot language, in sufficient time to meet the deadline for submission of the foregoing Charter amendments at the 2018 general election.

SECTION 5: The Village of Mogadore finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.
