SPONSOR: SAFETY COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND/OR CLERK/TREASURER TO AMEND THE CONTRACT PREVIOUSLY ENTERED INTO WITH THE OHIO PATROLMEN'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION BY ENTERING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: Full-time patrolmen and sergeants employed by the Village of Mogadore Police Department are members of the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association ("OPBA"); and,

WHEREAS: Policing services provided by these employees are governed by the terms and conditions set forth in contracts between the Village and the OPBA embodied in the Memorandum of Understanding attached hereto as Exhibit "A;" and,

WHEREAS: The current Contract with these employees covers 2018 through 2020 must be amended and approved by this Council; and,

WHEREAS: The Village, and the OPBA have negotiated an amendment to the Contract that changes the wage for officers in charge effective August 4, 2018; and,

WHEREAS, the amendment will serve the best interests of the Village residents; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is authorized and directed to execute a Memorandum of Understanding that amends the 2018-2020 contract entered into between the OPBA and the Village of Mogadore, in a form similar to the one attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

SECTION 2. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

SECTION 3. That, to the extent not already done so, the funds required for the payment of the obligations incurred are hereby appropriated for the purposes described.

SECTION 4. The Village of Mogadore finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this council and any of its committees that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.
