A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE PORTAGE COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION'S ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF APPORTIONING AND DISTRIBUTING THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Mogadore is a participating political subdivision and has been provided with an alternative method of apportioning the local government fund as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" attached to this Resolution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, majority of all the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: The Council of the Village of Mogadore does hereby accept the percentages set forth in the alternative method of apportioning and distributing the Local Government Fund, for a term of five (5) years, as set forth in the Exhibit "A".

<u>SECTION 2:</u> The Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Mogadore is hereby directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Portage, County Budget Commission.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that all deliberations of the Council and of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, immediately effective upon passage by a majority of the members elected to the Mogadore Village Council, in order for the County Auditor's to timely complete additional proceedings necessary for the submission of the Alternative Method of apportionment of local government funds to the State of Ohio by the required deadline.
