RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE TO ENTER INTO A CHANGE ORDER TO THE CONTRACT WITH CEMENTECH, INCORPORATED, AN INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Mogadore entered into a contract with Cementech, Incorporated for the Village of Mogadore fire station apron project; and,

WHEREAS, the Village evaluated the project and determined that a change order was and is necessary to the contract to allow for additional necessary work;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

- Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a change order to the current contract with Cementech, Incorporated to allow for additional work for the fire station apron project. The total additional cost of the change order is up to Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00), which shall be paid for by the Village pursuant to this Resolution. A bill outlining the additional work is attached as Exhibit "A."
- Section 2: That the Mayor and/or Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to make any additional payments to Cementech, Incorporated for this change order to the contract.
- Section 3: That, to the extent not already done so, the funds required for the payment of the obligations incurred are hereby appropriated for the purposes described.
- <u>Section 4:</u> That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.
- Section 5: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
