AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO SUPPORT THE CONTINUATION OF A GOVERNMENTAL NATURAL GAS AGGREGATION PROGRAM WITH OPT-OUT PROVISIONS PURSUANT TO SECTION 4929.26, OHIO REVISED CODE, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXTEND THE SUPPLY AGREEMENT WITH CONSTELLATION ENERGY SERVICES TO CONTINUE A NATURAL GAS AGGREGATION PROGRAM BEYOND MARCH 31, 2020 WHEN THE CURRENT SUPPLY AGREEMENT ENDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Mayor Rick explained this ordinance was needed to give permission to the broker to attempt to secure rates under 3.00 MCF by March 31, 2019. If the broker is able to secure the rate, this rate will be tied in until 2022.

<u>COMMENTS ON THE BILLS</u> - Ms. B. Van Dike made a motion to approve the payment of the bills as presented on the invoice report; Mr. R. Schrock seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS from the Public: June Long, 4061 Etter Rd; Ms. Long asked if she would have to opt-out of the proposed new gas aggregation agreement. She states that she already pays under \$3.00 with the supplier she is signed with.

Mayor Rick said that he will talk with the broker and let him know not to contact her.

COMMENTS from Council: Mr. M. Kelly thanked the Mayor for working with the utilities broker to try and get this lower rate for the gas aggregation. He also invited council to meet with him 45 minutes before the January 23 work session to discuss ways to promote passage of the income tax levy on the May ballot. Mayor Rick also asked if the clerk-treasurer would be able to meet with council also. He would like him to be involved in all the meetings regarding the levy.
