Ordinance No. 2019-16Passed February 20, 2019

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND REPLACING THE DEFINITIONS OF “NON-RESIDENT” AND “RESIDENT” IN THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE CODIFIED ORDINANCES SECTION 35.02, AND AMENDING AND REPLACING CODIFIED ORDINANCES SECTION 35.03(A), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this Council finds it appropriate and necessary to amend the definitions of “Resident” and “Non-Resident” as defined in Section 35.02 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Mogadore; and,

WHEREAS, this Council also finds it appropriate to update and amend the rate for Emergency Medical Services, for the purposes provided in Section 35.03(A) of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Mogadore.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Village of Mogadore Codified Ordinances Section 35.02 is hereby amended to replace the definitions of “Resident” an “Non-Resident” as follows:

NON-RESIDENT. For purposes of this subchapter only, a person not domiciled within the village or otherwise considered a resident under the definition of Resident in this section.

RESIDENT. For purpose of this section only:

- (1) A person domiciled within the village; or,
- (2) A person domiciled within the municipal boundaries of any city, village, or township with a mutual aid agreement with the Village of Mogadore when the emergency service is being supplied pursuant to such mutual aid agreement.

SECTION 2: That the Village of Mogadore Codified Ordinances Section 35.03(A) is hereby amended to state as follows:

(A)(1) Effective July 1, 2019, each person receiving emergency medical service from the village shall pay a utilization charge as determined in the Village’s duly adopted EMS fee table.

(2) As long as the Village of Mogadore is a designated Medicare, Medicaid and/or Workers’ Compensation provider, the village shall accept as total payment the rates and co-payments established for all individuals covered by these programs for the prevailing rate applicable to Mogadore, for both residents and non-residents.

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(3) As long as the Village of Mogadore is a designated Medicare, Medicaid and/or Workers' Compensation provider, the village shall accept as total payment the rates and co-payments established for all individuals covered by these programs for the prevailing rate applicable to Mogadore, for both residents and non-residents.

SECTION 3: That the EMS fee table attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is adopted and shall be effective on July 1, 2019.

SECTION 4: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Village residents, for the immediate implementation of these rules, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Administration and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
