SPONSOR: SAFETY COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ESO SOLUTIONS REGARDING THE ACQUISITION, INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF EMS SOFTWARE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor of the Village of Mogadore is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with ESO Solutions regarding the acquisition, installation and operation of a new emergency medical service (EMS) software system.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor, Fiscal Officer and Fire Chief are hereby authorized to sign all necessary paperwork to effectuate the entering of, execution and implementation of said agreement.

SECTION 3: That, to the extent not already done so, the funds required for the payment of the obligations incurred are hereby appropriated for the purposes described. The amount authorized herein for the EMS software shall be in an amount up to \$6,300.00, with anticipated reimbursement of approximately \$5,200.00 by Cleveland Clinic/Akron General Hospital. The Village anticipates with an approximate net cost to the Village of only \$990.00.

SECTION 4: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Village residents, to allow for the timely submission and implementation of the approved Agreement within guidelines and requirements, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Administration, the Fire/EMS department, and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
