SPONSOR: UTILITIES COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND CLERK-TREASURER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS TO PROVIDE FOR A TRASH AGGREGATION PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Mogadore seeks to negotiate a reduced rate for Solid Waste Disposal for the Village and its residents; and,

WHEREAS, Article XIII of the Charter permits the Village to enter into agreements pertaining to public utility systems, so long as the franchise agreement is non-exclusive; and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 50 of the Mogadore Codified Ordinances regulates Solid Waste Disposal throughout the Village and requires a permit; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: It is hereby determined necessary, proper and in the best interests of the Village of Mogadore and its residents that the Village of Mogadore enter into an agreement to provide for the aggregation of Solid Waste disposal for the Village and its residents.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer of the Village are hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for a Solid Waste/Trash Aggregation program for the Village and its residents, in accordance with specifications on file in the Office of the Clerk-Treasurer.

SECTION 3: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Village residents, to allow for the timely advertisement and then submission and execution of the approved Agreement within guidelines and requirements before the current trash aggregation agreement expires, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Administration and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
