AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE'S DONATION OF CERTAIN FIRE DEPARTMENT TURNOUT GEAR AND OTHER EQUIPMENT TO THE AKRON FIRE DEPARTMENT AND/OR THE AKRON FIRE ACADEMY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, This Council may donate Village equipment which it finds lacks value and is no longer needed for public use, is obsolete, or, is unfit for the use for which it was acquired; and,

WHEREAS, This Council wishes to adopt an Ordinance expressing its intent to authorize the donation of certain Mogadore Fire Department turnout gear and other equipment that is not needed for public use to the Akron Fire Department and/or Akron Fire Academy; and,

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to authorize the Mayor, Fiscal Officer and/or Fire Chief to donate the unneeded, obsolete or unfit certain Fire Department turnout gear.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: That this Council finds valueless and unneeded certain Fire Department turnout gear, including 19 coats, 21 pants, and 6 helmets.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The Mayor, Fiscal Officer and/or Fire Chief are hereby authorized and directed to donate the aforesaid Fire Department turnout gear, including 19 coats, 21 pants, and 6 helmets, to the Akron Fire Department and/or the Akron Fire Academy, as such equipment is no longer needed for municipal purposes.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: That the recitals set forth above are incorporated by reference herein.

SECTION 4: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Village residents, for the immediate implementation of this donation to the Akron Fire Department and/or Academy for its upcoming session, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Administration, Fire Department, and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
