SPONSOR: STREETS COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BLOCK GRANT (STBG), RESURFACING OR TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES SET ASIDE (TASA) FUNDS PROGRAMMED BY THE AKRON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY (AMATS), AND TO ACT AS A PARTNER WITH THE CITY OF AKRON AND/OR SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP, TO IMPROVE CERTAIN PORTIONS OF GILCHRIST ROAD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the AMATS Resurfacing Program provides financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Mogadore is planning to make capital improvements to Gilchrist Road and otherwise support and protect its residents; and,

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply as follows for Federal Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG), Resurfacing or Transportation Alternatives Set Aside (TASA) Funds programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) with the estimated cost of these two projects having yet to be determined and in acknowledgement of the AMATS "Funding Policy Guidelines:"

<u>Project</u>	Project Limits
Gilchrist Road Phase 1	Akron Corp. Limits to Mogadore Road
Gilchrist Road Phase 2	Monroe Falls Road to Akron Corp. Limits

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The Mayor and Village Engineer are hereby authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining the aforesaid financial assistance.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: That as a condition of this Resolution, the Village shall partner with and/or receive financial contribution from either the City of Akron or Springfield Township on Phase 2.

<u>SECTION 4</u>: That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

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SECTION 5: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.					
SECTION 6: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and to allow for the timely submission of the required application, as well as the continued operations of the Village Service Department, the Village Engineer's office and other departments and shall therefore take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
