Ordinance No. 2019-52Passed June 5, 2019

SPONSOR: FINANCE COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AMENDING SECTION 1 OF RESOLUTION NO. 2018-33; ESTABLISHING DUTIES AND ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR FULL-TIME MAINTENANCE AND GROUNDS SUPERVISOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: That Resolution No. 2018-33 Section 1, is hereby amended to state as follows:

That the Maintenance and Grounds Supervisor shall be responsible for the care of the Municipal Building, the grounds surrounding the Municipal Building including the leased lot from Omnova, the property at the Historical Society, the grounds at the Veterans Park, the Community Center, the Police Station, the area between the railroad tracks on N. Cleveland Avenue, the flower gardens beneath the "Welcome to Mogadore" signs, and shall perform such other duties as the Council would hereafter describe. Said Maintenance and Grounds Supervisor shall be compensated for such services at an annual salary of \$44,953.67 which shall be payable bi-weekly.

In addition, the Maintenance and Grounds Supervisor shall receive a clothing allowance of \$325.00 for each year. It is required that the Mayor approve any and all purchases prior to the expenditure of said clothing fund. Employee may elect to receive either a cash clothing allowance or obtain purchase orders. If cash allowance is elected, allocation will be the same as that of the Police Department.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall be effective retroactively as of June 1, 2019.

SECTION 3: The Village of Mogadore finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the residents of the Village of Mogadore and for the reason that concerns the continued and efficient operation of the Mogadore Service Department and therefore, shall be in full force and effect upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor or at the earliest period allowed by law.
