A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH OHIO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

SPONSOR: SAFETY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, this Council finds it appropriate and necessary to enter into an agreement with Ohio Department of Public Safety regarding the State Plan of Operation between the State of Ohio and the Mogadore Police Department; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor of the Village of Mogadore is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Ohio Department of Public Safety regarding the State Plan of Operation between the State of Ohio and Mogadore Police Department, the Village of Mogadore, Ohio with respect to excess Department of Defense personal property transferred pursuant to §2576a in order to promote the efficient and expeditious transfer of property and to ensure accountability of the same.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor, Clerk-Treasurer and Police Chief are hereby authorized to sign and process all necessary paperwork to effectuate the entering of, execution and implementation of said agreement.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

SECTION 4: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>SECTION 5</u>: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Village residents, to allow for the timely submission of the approved Agreement within guidelines and requirements, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Administration and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
