Ordinance No. 2019-72Passed August 21, 2019

SPONSOR: SAFETY COMMITTEE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A 2020 FORD EXPLORER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Village Council has determined the need to purchase one (1) 2020 Ford Explorer for the Police Department; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Village Council have determined that it is in the best financial interests of the Village to acquire the aforesaid equipment by lease with an option to purchase from Lebanon Ford in Lebanon, Ohio through a purchase agreement in an amount not to exceed \$55,000.00 (amount to also include amount needed to up fit, equipment and mark the vehicle for use as a police cruiser), plus financing costs as set forth in the proposal, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A (the "Proposal"); and,

WHEREAS, the aforesaid equipment and the cost proposal from Lebanon Ford were selected from a State Term Schedule maintained by the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services and will be purchased under the Cooperative Purchasing Program, which satisfies the requirements for competitive bidding under the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1: This Council hereby authorizes the purchase of one (1) 2020 Ford Explorer for the Police Department, in an amount not to exceed the total acquisition cost of \$55,000.00 (this amount includes money needed to up fit, equipment and mark the vehicle for use as a police cruiser), plus financing and other costs as set forth in the Proposal.

Section 2: This Council hereby authorizes the Mayor, Clerk-Treasurer and the Chief of Police to take such actions as shall be necessary to acquire the aforesaid equipment in accordance with the Proposal and this Ordinance.

Section 3: That the factual findings and statements set forth in the recitals above are hereby adopted and incorporated herein.

Section 4: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: This Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience, and welfare of the Village of Mogadore and the inhabitants thereof, and permits the Village to acquire the aforesaid equipment to timely complete necessary work and update equipment thereby maintaining and even improving service levels within the Village, and provided it receives the approval of two-thirds of the members of Council, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, or otherwise take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
