SPONSOR: FINANCE COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CLERK-TREASURER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR LABOR AND MATERIALS FOR A GENERATOR TO POWER THE POLICE STATION, FIRE STATION AND ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: It is hereby determined necessary and in the best interest of the residents of Mogadore that the Village enter into a contract for labor and materials necessary for the purchase and installation of a generator to power the Police Station, Fire Station and Administrative Offices of the Village.

SECTION 2: The Clerk-Treasurer of the Village is hereby directed to advertise for bids for the generator in accordance with Section 1 hereof, the Ohio Revised Code, and the Village Charter and its Codified Ordinances.


SECTION 3: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Village residents, to allow for the timely advertisement and then submission and execution of the approved Agreement given the condition of the current generator, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Administration and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
