

Mayor Rick opened the Public Hearing at 5:30 pm for discussion on proposed Ordinance 2019-62 and Ordinance 2019-63. No comments by council or public. Public Hearing closed.

Council met in regular session at 5:33 p.m. with Mayor Rick presiding.

Mr. R. Schrock asked everyone to join him in a moment of reflection for their own intentions. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all.

Motion by Mr. R. Schrock, second by Ms. B. Van Dike for the approval of the agenda as presented. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Ms. B. Van Dike, second by Mr. R. Schrock to adopt the minutes of the August 7, 2019 Council meeting. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS ON PENDING LEGISLATION – No comments.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

PARKS – Ms. Miller reported the next Parks Board meeting will be Tuesday, August 27 at 7:00.

UTILITIES – Mr. McDowall had no report.

SAFETY – Mr. Kelly had no report.

STREETS – Mr. Yoho had no report.

PLANNING AND ZONING – Mr. Schrock reported he has the third reading on two pieces of legislation and two ordinances to read.

FINANCE/AUDIT – Ms. Van Dike reported she has two pieces of legislation to read.

Mr. Raddish said the August Work Session will be Wednesday, August 28 at 5:30 with all committees reporting.

OLD BUSINESS –

Mr. R. Schrock presented the third reading of Ordinance 2019-62 sponsored by the Planning and Zoning Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ADDING THE DEFINITIONS OF “CONSTRUCTION DUMPSTER,” “DUMPSTER BAG,” AND “RUBBISH DUMPSTER” IN SECTION 152.002 OF THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE CODIFIED ORDINANCES AND ESTABLISHING SECTIONS 152.034 AND 152.035 IN THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES

A motion was made by Mr. R. Schrock to adopt Ordinance 2019-62; a second was made by Mr. M. Kelly. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. R. Schrock presented the third reading of Ordinance 2019-63 sponsored by the Planning and Zoning Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE CREATING CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 152.034 REGARDING VEHICLE SALES ON COMMERCIAL LOTS, AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 152.047(A)(8)

A motion was made by Mr. R. Schrock to adopt Ordinance 2019-63; a second was made Mr. M. Kelly.

Mr. M. Pitchford said Ordinance 2019-63 will need an amendment to read “An Ordinance Creating Ordinance Section 152.036 Regarding Vehicle Sales on Commercial Lots, Amending Codified Ordinance Section 152.047(A)(8).” The reason for the change is Ordinance 2019-62 has Sections 152.034 and 152.035 and had to pass before 2019-63 could be amended.

Mr. M. Kelly made a motion to amend Ordinance 2019-63; a second was made by Ms. B. Van Dike. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. R. Schrock to adopt Ordinance 2019-63 as amended; a second was made by Mr. M. Kelly. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS –

Mr. M. Kelly presented Ordinance 2019-72 sponsored by the Safety Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A 2020 FORD EXPLORER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Mr. M. Kelly made a motion to suspend the rule requiring three readings; Ms. B. Van Dike seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. M. Kelly to adopt Ordinance 2019-72; a second was made by Mr. R. Schrock. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Ms. B. Van Dike presented Resolution 2019-73 sponsored by the Finance Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2019 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Ms. B. Van Dike made a motion to suspend the rule requiring three readings; Mr. R. McDowall seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt Resolution 2019-73; a second was made by Mr. R. McDowall. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. R. Schrock presented Resolution 2019-74 sponsored by the Planning and Zoning Committee as follows:

ORDINANCE LEVYING SPEICAL ASSESSMENTS FOR VARIOUS SUMMIT COUNTY PROPERTIES, MOGADORE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Mr. R. Schrock made a motion to suspend the rule requiring three readings. Mr. M. Kelly seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. R. Schrock to adopt Resolution 2019-74; a second was made by Mr. M. Kelly.

Mayor Rick stated these properties were issued citations within the last year for high grass and debris and they were ignored then the village had to mow and clean up.

Mr. R. Schrock asked if the village would receive payment for the assessments. When the property is sold, we would receive payment.

Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. R. Schrock presented Ordinance 2019-75 sponsored by the Planning and Zoning Committee as follows:

A motion was made by Mr. R. Schrock to adopt Ordinance 2019-75; a second was made by Mr. M. Kelly.

Mayor Rick said this ordinance was for a junk vehicle summoned to Mayor's Court and did not pay the fine.

Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS ON THE BILLS – Ms. B. Van Dike made a motion to approve the payment of the bills as presented on the invoice report. Mr. R. Schrock seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS from the Public: June Long, 4061 Etter Rd; thanked the Mayor and Street Department for the tree limb pickup after the Sunday storm.

Mayor Rick announced the Street Department would be picking up tree limbs from the storm on Thursday and Friday of this week. They started the pick up today. He also said the Street Department was out three hours after the storm cleaning limbs and branches from North Cleveland, Idella and others that were covered.

Rebecca Beck, 3367 Curtis St.; commented on the ongoing issues with the neighbors, noise, high grass, open burn and spraying her dogs through the fence. She stated she has called the police numerous times regarding the issues and nothing can be done. She asked for copies of ordinances.

Mayor Rick told her to continue calling the police when any issue arises; he will talk to Chief Higgins. He also told her the office will make copies of the ordinances she would like to see.

COMMENTS from Council: Mr. M. Kelly would like the Police Department to place one of the speed signs on Hale Street due to the school starting and the football/cheerleading activities at the park.

Mr. Kelly asked if the Village was receiving the monthly payments from Spin and Win. The Village receives the payments every month. He has heard complaints regarding the Spin and Win and paying cash for the pay offs.

Mr. Kelly would like a letter to the owner at 111 Williams Ave. regarding her feeding of feral cats and the problem it is causing the neighbors. Mr. Pitchford stated Summit County has an ordinance but the village would be responsible for the execution of it. We would have to trap and transport the animals at a cost to the village.

Mr. Kelly stated the neighbors have proof of the animals leaving their waste in their yards. He asked the Law Director to look into ordinances council could pass to help remedy by this situation. Council could discuss at the next Work Session.

Mr. Kelly stated at the next Work Session he was going to present the issue of spending \$30,000 for hoses the Fire Department needs.

Mr. Kelly asked Council President Raddish if council could enter into Executive Session to discuss land sale.

Mr. R. McDowall thanked the Street Department for the limb pickup.
