AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SETTING THE MAYOR'S COURT COSTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the allowable court costs have recently been raised.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: That this Council finds it necessary to and does hereby amend the amount of costs for Mayor's Court and raises the amount to \$117.00 with the following breakdown:

•	Indigent Defense Support Fund	\$ 20.00
٠	Victims of Crime	\$ 9.00
•	Indigent Defense Support Fund	\$ 5.00
•	Drug Law Enforcement Fund	\$ 3.50
•	Indigent Driver Alcohol Treatment Fund - Summit	\$ 1.50
•	Computer Fund – Office	\$ 5.00
•	Traffic Safety Initiatives and Training	\$ 5.00
•	Village General Revenue	<u>\$ 68.00</u>

SECTION 2: All state-mandated costs shall be paid with each case number. This amount is currently \$37.50 on each case number, but is subject to immediate change should the State of Ohio mandate and/or allow a higher cost per case.

SECTION 3: Local court costs are \$78.00 per case.

SECTION 4: All other ordinances, resolutions, or parts of other ordinances and resolutions which may be in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared null and void and are of no further force and effect.

SECTION 5: That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance.

SECTION 6: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
