AN ORDINANCE CEASING COLLECTION OF THE ALCOHOL AND CHEMICAL SUBSTANCE EDUCATION AND PREVENTION FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: That this Council finds it necessary to stop collection of the Alcohol and Chemical Substance Education and Prevention Fund. As such, as of the effective date of the Ordinance, the Village of Mayor's Court shall no longer collect the \$9.00 per case charge for this special fund.

SECTION 2: All other ordinances, resolutions, or parts of other ordinances and resolutions which may be in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared null and void and are of no further force and effect.

SECTION 3: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Village residents, for the immediate implementation of this rule given the fact that the fees are no longer being collected, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Administration, Mayor's Court, Police Department, and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
