AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENTS OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF MOGADORE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinance of Mogadore, Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, Numerous sections of the Traffic and General Offenses Codes need to be amended or enacted so as to conform to enactments of the Ohio General Assembly; and,

WHEREAS, Council has entered into a contract with the American Legal Publishing Company to prepare and publish such revisions which are now before Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The attached referenced sections of the Traffic and General Offenses Codes, as amended, are hereby approved and adopted as amended or enacted so as to conform to enactments of the Ohio General Assembly. More specifically, the stricken items are repealed (deleted) and the highlighted items are being established (added).

SECTION 2: That the Clerk-Treasurer, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 731.21 shall publish a succinct summary of this Ordinance which shall contain notice that the complete text of this Ordinance may be obtained or viewed, and the Codified Ordinances viewed, at the office of the Clerk-Treasurer and may be viewed at any other location designated by Council.

SECTION 3: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety for the reason that there exists an imperative necessity for the earliest publication and distribution of the current version of the Mogadore Codified Ordinances to the officials and residents of the Municipality, so as to facilitate administration, law enforcement, the daily operation and avoid legal entanglements, including conflict with general State law, and therefore shall take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
