Α RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING AND APPOINTING **ERIC** BERKHEIMER AS INTERIM POLICE CHIEF FOR THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: That, retroactively effective October 28, 2019, Eric Berkheimer shall be and is hereby appointed to the position of Interim Police Chief for the Village of Mogadore, Ohio. Interim Chief Eric Berkheimer shall hold said position until Chief Todd Higgins returns from leave and to active service.

SECTION 2: That during this appointment, Interim Chief Eric Berkheimer shall be paid the same rate of compensation and shall have the same holiday package as the Chief of Police.

SECTION 3: That during this appointment, Interim Chief Eric Berkheimer shall maintain all rights and obligations associated with the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association along with all rights under the Village's contract with the same.

SECTION 4: That upon Chief Higgins return from leave, Eric Berkheimer shall be immediately restored to his prior position of Sergeant within the Police Department.

SECTION 5: That Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety of the Village residents and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Police Department and Police Chief and shall therefore take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
