AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A SNOW AND ICE TRUCK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Village Council have determined the need to purchase one (1) 2021 International snow and ice truck for the Village; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Village Council have determined that it is in the best financial interests of the Village to acquire the aforesaid equipment by purchase from Rush Truck Center and Gledhill Road Machinery through a purchase agreement in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.00, plus financing costs; and,

WHEREAS, the aforesaid equipment and the cost proposal from Rush Truck Center and Gledhill Road Machinery were selected from a State Term Schedule maintained by the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services and will be purchased under the Cooperative Purchasing Program, which satisfies the requirements for competitive bidding under the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1: This Council hereby authorizes the purchase of one (1) 2021 International snow and ice truck for the Village, in an amount not to exceed the total acquisition cost of \$200,000.00, which amount includes money needed to up fit, equipment and mark the vehicle for use as a snow and ice truck, plus financing and other costs as required. The truck and equipment shall be purchased according to the State Term Schedule from Rush Truck Center and/or Gledhill Road Machinery.

Section 2: This Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer to take such actions as shall be necessary to acquire the aforesaid vehicle and equipment in accordance with this Ordinance.

Section 3: That the factual findings and statements set forth in the recitals above are hereby adopted and incorporated herein.

Section 4: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: This Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience, and welfare of the Village of Mogadore and the inhabitants thereof, and permits the Village to acquire the aforesaid equipment to timely complete necessary work and update equipment thereby maintaining and even improving service levels within the Village during inclement weather, and provided it receives the approval of two-thirds of the members of Council, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, or otherwise take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
