Ordinance No. 2020-13

SPONSOR: PARKS COMMITTEE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE'S DONATION OF SIX FOLDING CHAIRS FROM THE PRY COMMUNITY CENTER TO THE CORNERSTONE CHURCH, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, This Council may donate Village equipment which it finds lacks value and is no longer needed for public use, is obsolete, or, is unfit for the use for which it was acquired; and,

WHEREAS, This Council wishes to adopt an Ordinance expressing its intent to authorize the donation of six folding chairs from the Pry Community Center that is not needed for public use to the Cornerstone Church; and,

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to authorize the Mayor, Fiscal Officer and/or Clerk-Treasurer to donate the unneeded, obsolete or unfit certain Fire Department turnout gear.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: That this Council finds valueless and unneeded the six folding chairs currently kept at the Russell Pry Community Center.

SECTION 2: The Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to donate the aforesaid six folding chairs to the Cornerstone Church, as such equipment is no longer needed for municipal purposes.

SECTION 3: That the recitals set forth above are incorporated by reference herein.

SECTION 4: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Village residents, for the immediate implementation of this donation to the Cornerstone Church, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Administration, Fire Department, and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
