Ordinance No. 2020-16Passed February 19, 2020

SPONSOR: FINANCE COMMITTEE

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN EQUIPMENT AS OBSOLETE AND UNFIT AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE TO HAVE SAID EQUIPMENT SOLD OR DESTROYED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, This Council may sell or destroy Village equipment which it finds lacks value and is no longer needed for public use, is obsolete, or, is unfit for the use for which it was acquired; and,

WHEREAS, This Council wishes to adopt an Ordinance expressing its intent to authorize the destruction or sale of certain Mogadore Administration, Police and Mayor Court Departments equipment that is not needed for public use and found to be obsolete or unfit; and,

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to authorize the Mayor, Fiscal Officer and/or Police Chief to have the obsolete or unfit equipment destroyed or sold.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: That this Council finds valueless and unneeded certain Village equipment, said equipment being set forth on Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2: The Mayor, Fiscal Officer and/or Police Chief are hereby authorized and directed to have said obsolete and unfit equipment destroyed or sold, as such equipment is no longer needed for municipal purposes.

SECTION 3: That the recitals set forth above are incorporated by reference herein.

SECTION 4: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Village residents, for the immediate implementation of the destruction or sale of certain obsolete and unfit equipment, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Administration, Police Department, Mayor Court and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.


