SPONSOR: SAFETY COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT FOR PURPOSES OF PROVIDING TEMPORARY HOUSING FOR MOGADORE'S FIRST RESPONDERS DURING THE COVID-19 CRISIS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the County of Summit has entered into a Mutual Aid Agreement for Non-Congregate Housing (Agreement) with the Residence Inn by Marriott located in Fairlawn, Ohio pursuant to the authority set forth in the March 31, 2020, order issued by the Director of the Ohio Department of Health titled the "Order for Non-Congregate Sheltering to be utilized throughout Ohio" ("The Order"); and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor desires to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the County of Summit to provide housing for first responders and health care workers who may have been exposed to COVID-19 as a result of their employment, are not symptomatic, but do not wish to shelter at home; and,

WHEREAS, it would benefit the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Mogadore to have temporary housing for Mogadore's first responders during the COVID-19 crisis.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio that:

Section 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the County of Summit regarding providing temporary housing for Mogadore's first responders during the COVID-19 crisis and execute on behalf of the Village in a form substantially similar to the one attached as Exhibit "A" hereto.

Section 2: That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 3: That, to the extent not already done so, the funds required for the payment of the obligations incurred are hereby appropriated for the purposes described.

Section 4: All formal actions of this Council related to this Resolution and all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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Section 5: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare for the reason that it is necessary to ensure the efficient and continuous operation of the Village Police and Fire Departments during the present COVID-19 crisis, and to allow for the possibility that numbers of healthy police officers could be threatened during the duration of the present crisis, and, therefore, this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its enactment and approval by the Mayor.
