

Council met in special session at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Rick presiding.

Ms. B. Van Dike asked everyone to join her in a moment of reflection for their own intentions. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all.

Due to the COVID-19 health crisis and approved emergency measures, council meeting was in session on Facebook Teams format.

Present in council chambers was Mayor Rick, Council President M. Raddish, Council Member B. Van Dike.

Present by remote was Council Members: C. Yoho, reported in at 5:34, R. McDowall, J. Tonsic, M. Kelly, K. Miller, Law Director, M. Pitchford, Clerk-Treasurer, S. Varney and Village Engineer, M. Glass.

Motion by Mr. M. Raddish, second by Mr. M. Kelly for the approval of the agenda as presented. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS –

Mr. M. Raddish presented Resolution 2020-31 sponsored by the Safety Committee as follows:

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY AN ADDITIONAL TAX AT THE RATE OF 3.5 MILL AND REQUESTING SUMMIT COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER TO CERTIFY THE TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF THE VILLAGE AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY THIS LEVY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Mr. M. Raddish made a motion to suspend the rule requiring three readings; Mr. M. Kelly seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. M. Raddish to adopt Resolution 2020-31; a second was made by Mr. M. Kelly.

Mayor Rick said Mr. S. Varney and Mr. M. Pitchford verified passing this levy in August or November, the collections would not begin until January 2021.

Mr. J. Tonsic asked the cost to the village for an August election could cost the village up to \$10,000, what would the cost be on a November ballot.

Mayor Rick answered there would be no cost to the village for a November ballot because of this being a presidential election year.

Mr. J. Tonsic said it will be financially beneficial to the village to wait until November to place this issue on the ballot.

Mayor Rick stated due to the pandemic it could take at least up to two months to determine the fiscal status of the Village. Also, if this levy is placed on the November election, there will be a breakdown of how the monies will be spent.

Vote. 1 Yes, 6 Nos. Motion failed.


