

Council met in regular session at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Rick presiding.

Ms. B. Van Dike asked everyone to join her in a moment of reflection for their own intentions. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all.

Due to the COVID-19 health crisis and approved emergency measures, council meeting was in session on Facebook Teams format.

Present in council chambers was Mayor Rick, Council President M. Raddish, Council Member B. Van Dike.

Present by remote was Council Members: C. Yoho, R. McDowall, J. Tonsic, M. Kelly, K. Miller, Law Director, M. Pitchford, Clerk-Treasurer, S. Varney and Village Engineer, M. Glass.

Motion by Mr. M. Raddish, second by Ms. B. Van Dike for the approval of the agenda as presented. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. M. Raddish, second by Mr. C. Yoho to adopt the minutes of the April 22, 2020 Council meeting. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. M. Raddish, second by Ms. K. Miller to adopt the minutes of the May 1, 2020 Special Council meeting. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS –

Mr. M. Raddish presented Ordinance 2020-32 sponsored by the Utilities Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A PETITION FOR SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR SPECIAL ENERGY IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND A PLAN FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS; APPROVING THE NECESSITY OF ACQUIRING, CONSTRUCTION, AND IMPROVING CERTAIN PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS IN THE VILLAGE IN COOPERATION WITH THE AKRON-SUMMIT COUNTY ENERGY SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT; DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH SUCH PROJECT; AND DETERMINING TO LEVY SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Mr. M. Raddish made a motion to suspend the rule requiring three readings; Mr. C. Yoho seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. M. Raddish to adopt Ordinance 2020-32; a second was made by Mr C. Yoho.

Mayor Rick said this a Summit County special energy program that will involve the Pry Community Center. This program started out giving loans to individual communities and if another community has adjacent borders, they can apply, which we can. Eventually, this program will be open to residents and commercial businesses.

Mr. Pitchford stated this program will be primarily for commercial businesses.

Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Ms. B. Van Dike presented Resolution 2020-33 sponsored by the Finance Committee as follows:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE LAW DIRECTOR TO ACCEPT THE ONE OHIO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING REGARDING THE PURSUIT AND USE OF POTENTIAL OPIOID LITIGATION SETTLEMENT FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Mayor Rick said this is a Memo of Understanding of the legislation. Mr. Pitchford said National Council Commission is asking all communities to sign the MOU. When all signatures are received, the commission will make the determination of funding.

Mr. M. Kelly thanked Mr. Pitchford for his work on the opioid litigation settlements.

Mr. M. Raddish asked what businesses in Mogadore benefited from the \$25,000 small business grants that council passed legislation a couple of weeks ago.

Mayor Rick said there were six businesses that received funds. Summit County was able to find additional \$5,000 for the sixth business. He will have the list at the next council meeting.


Ms. B. Van Dike stated that she would like to congratulate a village resident, Lisa Kelly, for being selected as Summa Health ‘Nurse of the Year.’

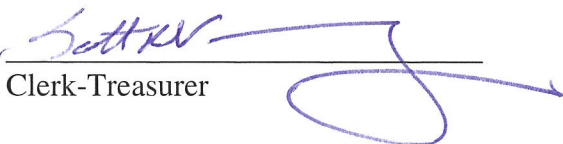
