AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SETTING THE MAYOR'S COURT FINE SCHEDULE,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore,
Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:


SECTION 1: That this Council finds it necessary to and does hereby amend the amount of
fines for Mayor's Court and raises the amount to those listed on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.


SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is effective immediately as of September 1, 2020.

SECTION 3: All other ordinances, resolutions, or parts of other ordinances and resolutions
which may be in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared null and void
and are of no further force and effect.


SECTION 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating
to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council
and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public,
in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio
Revised Code and HB 197 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Village
residents, for the immediate implementation, and to allow for the continued operations of the
Village Mayor's Court and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after
its passage.
