Ordinance No. 2020-51

SPONSOR: SAFETY COMMITTEE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE CODIFIED ORDINANCE 71.07(A), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly recently amended Revised Code 4549.10 to allow vehicles to operate with only one license plate; and,

WHEREAS, this Council finds it appropriate and necessary to amend C.O. 71.07(A); and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of and furthers the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the Village residents to amend Section 71.07(A) of the Village of Mogadore's Codified Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Village of Mogadore Codified Ordinance Section 71.07(A) is hereby amended as follows:

(A) No person shall operate or cause to be operated upon a public road or highway a motor vehicle of a manufacturer or dealer unless the vehicle carries and displays a placard, except as provided in R.C. § 4503.21, issued by the Director of Public Safety that displays the registration number of its manufacturer or dealer.

SECTION 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and HB 197 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to bring the Codified Ordinances into conformity with state law, for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Village residents, for the immediate implementation of this rule, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Police Department and other departments shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
