

COUNCIL MEETING

August 5, 2020

Council met in regular session at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Rick presiding.

Mr. B. Van Dike asked everyone to join her in a moment of reflection for their own intentions. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all.

Due to the COVID-19 health crisis and approved emergency measures, council meeting was in session on Facebook Teams format.

Present in council chambers was Mayor Rick, Council President M. Raddish, Council Member B. Van Dike.

Motion by Mr. M. Raddish, second by Ms. B. Van Dike for the approval of the agenda as presented. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. M. Raddish, second by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt the minutes of the July 15, 2020 Council meeting. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS – Mr. M. Raddish presented the second reading of Ordinance 2020-45 sponsored by the Safety Committee as follows:

AUTHORIZING AND ESTABLISHING THE SUNRISE BLVD OPWC FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Ms. B. Van Dike presented Resolution 2020-54 sponsored by the Finance Committee as follows:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFERS WITHIN FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Ms. B. Van Dike made a motion to suspend the rule requiring three readings; Ms. K. Miller seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt Resolution 2020-54; a second was made by Mr. C. Yoho. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS from Council:

Mr. M. Kelly said he has had residents asking about what is the new business going in at the old tanning salon. The Mayor said it will be an eye doctor.

Mr. M. Raddish announced the August Work Session will be Wednesday, August 26 at 5:30 with all committees reporting.

Comments from the Village Engineer: Mr. M. Glass stated the Sunrise W & S project will start in September and the Prospect Street project will be completed next week.

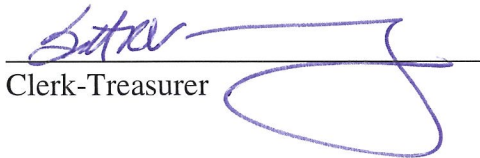
Comments from the Mayor: None.
