A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SUMMIT COUNTY REGARDING SERVICES OF POLICE DIVERSION YOUTH DIVISION FOR JUVENILES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor, Police Chief and Assistant Clerk Treasurer of the Village of Mogadore is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement retroactive to July 1, 2020 with the County of Summit regarding the police diversion youth division for juveniles in order to provide immediate community based sanctions for unruly and misdemeanor offending youth. The agreement shall be in a form substantially similar to the one attached as Exhibit "A" hereto.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: That the Mayor, Police Chief and Assistant Clerk Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to sign all necessary paperwork to effectuate the entering of, execution and implementation of said agreement retroactive to July 1, 2020.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: That, to the extent not already done so, the funds required for the payment of the obligations incurred are hereby appropriated for the purposes described.

SECTION 4: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and HB 197 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.

<u>SECTION 6</u>: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Village residents, to allow for the timely submission of the approved Agreement within guidelines and requirements, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Administration and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
