Ordinance No. 2020-58Passed September 2, 2020

SPONSOR: UTILITIES COMMITTEE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 50.08 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council finds it appropriate and necessary to amend Codified Ordinance 50.08 to create a deadline to take inside trash receptacles; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of and furthers the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the Village residents to amend Section 50.08 of the Village of Mogadore's Codified Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Village of Mogadore Codified Ordinances Section 50.08 is hereby amended as follows:

§ 50.08 LIMITATIONS ON COLLECTION OF SOLID WASTE, RECYCLABLES AND YARD WASTE

Residential pickup of solid waste, recyclables and yard waste is hereby limited to Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. Such materials may not be placed on the curb for collection prior to 6:00 p.m. on the date prior to actual collection. All trash receptacles shall be removed from the curb no later than 7:00 p.m. on the date of collection. No garbage and/or rubbish collector shall collect and/or dispose of rubbish within the village between 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. the following day.

SECTION 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and HB 197 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Village residents, for the immediate implementation of these rules, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Administration and other departments shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.


