Ordinance No. 2020-61Passed September 2, 2020

SPONSOR: FINANCE COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ROETZEL CONSULTING SOLUTIONS REGARDING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS CONSULTING SERVICES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this Council finds it appropriate and necessary to enter into an agreement with Roetzel Consulting Solutions regarding economic development and intergovernmental relations consulting services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor of the Village of Mogadore is hereby authorized, retroactively to September 1, 2020, to enter into a one-year, renewable agreement with Roetzel Consulting Solutions, regarding economic development and intergovernmental relations consulting services, in a form substantially similar to the one attached as Exhibit "A" hereto.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized to sign and process all necessary paperwork to effectuate the entering of, execution and implementation of said agreement.

SECTION 3: That, to the extent not already done so, the funds required for the payment of the obligations incurred are hereby appropriated for the purposes described.

SECTION 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and HB 197 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.

SECTION 5: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience, and welfare of the Village of Mogadore and the inhabitants thereof, and for the further reason that this Resolution must be immediately effective in order to provide for the immediate safety services provided for herein, which are necessary to preserve and protect the residents and interests of the Village. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
