

COUNCIL MEETING

September 2, 2020

Council met in regular session at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Rick presiding.

Mr. M. Raddish asked everyone to join him in a moment of reflection for their own intentions. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all.

Due to the COVID-19 health crisis and approved emergency measures, council meeting was in session on Facebook Teams format.

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PASSAGE OF HE AKRON ZOOLOGICAL PARK'S (AKRON ZOO) RENEWAL WITH AN INCREASE LEVY, TO APPEAR ON THE BALLOT AT THE GENERAL ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020 AND URGING THE RESIDENTS OF MOGADORE TO VOTE IN FAVOR OF THE LEVY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Mayor: No comments.

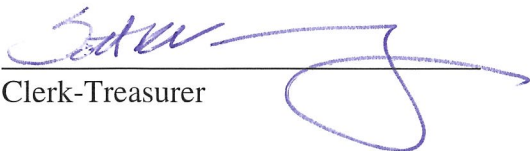
