Ordinance No. 2020-80Passed November 4, 2020

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENTS OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF MOGADORE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinance of Mogadore, Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, Council has entered into a contract with the American Legal Publishing Company to prepare and publish such revisions which are now before Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: That the editing, arrangement and numbering or renumbering of the following ordinances and parts of ordinances are hereby approved as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of Mogadore, Ohio, so as to conform to the classification and numbering system of the Codified Ordinances, to-wit:

SECTION 2: That the Clerk-Treasurer, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 731.21 shall publish a succinct summary of this Ordinance which shall contain notice that the complete text of this Ordinance may be obtained or viewed, and the Codified Ordinances viewed, at the office of the Clerk-Treasurer and may be viewed at any other location designated by Council.

SECTION 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in a duly noticed, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and HB 197 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.
