Joe Henico, 3773 Argonne, brought up texting while driving. In the state of Ohio is it a secondary offense and wants to know if communities can make this a primary offense. Law Director Mr. Pitchford stated this was looked into once before. Suggestion was to keep consistent with state law, otherwise this could be held as unconstitutional.

COMMENTS from Council: Mr. J. Tonsic voiced his concern on the two COVID-19 cases at the middle school. Mayor Rick stated the school is following protocol by reporting new cases to the Summit County Health Department and notifying parents as well. There is no "all-call" system to every resident in the Village. Mr. Tonsic stated he just wants to see transparency.

Clerk-Treasurer: No comments.


COMMENTS from the Mayor:


He informed Council an Executive Session is needed at the end of tonight's Council meeting to discuss personnel and bargaining issues.
