

COUNCIL MEETING

October 7, 2020

Council met in regular session at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Rick presiding.

Mr. M. Raddish asked everyone to join him in a moment of reflection for their own intentions. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all.

Due to COVID-19, the Council Meeting was moved to the Pry Community Center for safe distancing. Council members could remote into the meeting if they chose to do so. Also, the meeting was opened to the public.

Present at the community center was Mayor Rick, Council President M. Raddish, Council Members B. Van Dike, K. Miller, M. Kelly.

Present by remote was Council Members: R. McDowall and J. Tonsic, Law Director Marshal Pitchford, Clerk-Treasurer, S. Varney and Village Engineer, M. Glass.

Due to issues remoting into the meeting, C. Yoho was not present.

Motion by Mr. M. Raddish, second by Mr. M. Kelly for the approval of the agenda as presented. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. M. Raddish, second by Mr. M. Kelly to adopt the minutes of the September 16, 2020 Council meeting. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS –

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Ms. B. Van Dike made a motion to suspend the rule requiring three readings; Mr. M. Kelly seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt Resolution 2020-65; a second was made by Mr. M. Kelly.

Mayor Rick said this annual resolution is an acceptance of the levies limitations.

Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. M. Kelly presented Resolution 2020-66 sponsored by Safety Committee as follows:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SELL UNNEEDED PERSONAL PROEPRTY (2011 CROWN VICTORIA POLICE CRUISER) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Mr. M. Kelly made a motion to suspend the rule requiring three readings; Ms. B. Van Dike seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. M. Kelly to adopt Resolution 2020-67; a second was made by Ms. B. Van Dike. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mayor Rick presented Ordinance 2020-68 as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ENATING AND ADOPTING A SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINACES FOR THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Mr. M. Raddish made a motion to suspend the rule requiring three readings; Mr. M. Kelly seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. M. Raddish to adopt Resolution 2020-68; a second was made by Mr. M. Kelly.

Mr. M. Pitchford said this ordinance is to adopt the 2019 Ohio General Assembly statutes and to update our ordinance books.

Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion passed.

Mr. M. Kelly commented on the remodel at 67 S. Cleveland, the Mogadore Eye Care and how good it looks, plus it will be an asset to the Village

Law Director: No comments.


Village Engineer: No comments.

Meeting adjourned at 5:42 p.m.


