Ordinance No. 2020-105

SPONSOR: UTILITIES COMMITTEE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE CODIFIED ORDINANCE CHAPTER 50 REGARDING THE DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE AND RELATED MATTERS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the voters of Mogadore approved an amendment to the Village Charter allowing for the ability to have one, exclusive provider of solid waste disposal and recycling; and,

WHEREAS, after a through Request for Proposal process, this Council found it appropriate and necessary to enter into an agreement with Kimble Recycling & Disposal, Inc. for the exclusive right to provide trash hauling within the Village beginning March 1, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, this Council finds it appropriate and necessary to amend C.O. 50; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of and furthers the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the Village residents to amend Section 50 of the Village of Mogadore's Codified Ordinances to bring it into conformity with the amended Village Charter and establish proper rules and regulations consistent thereunder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Village of Mogadore Codified Ordinances Section 50 is hereby amended as set forth on the attached Exhibit "A."

SECTION 2: That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and HB 404 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Village residents, for the immediate implementation of these rules and regulations to govern the transition to an exclusive solids waste and recycling provider, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Administration and other departments shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
