## RESOLUTION AND ORDER ACCEPTING THE BID AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK-TREASURER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR LABOR AND MATERIALS FOR A GENERATOR TO POWER THE POLICE STATION, FIRE STATION AND ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the Village Engineer, a copy of which is attached hereto, have reviewed and accepted a bid for supplying labor and materials necessary for a generator to power the Police Station, Fire Station and Administrative Offices and have accepted a bid; and,

WHEREAS, Council has this day accepted the bid from Beck Electric Company for supplying labor and materials necessary for a generator to power the Police Station, Fire Station and Administrative Offices, which was previously found necessary to be done; and,

WHEREAS, said bid was the lowest responsive and responsible bid for the improvement at \$75,100.00.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor, Clerk-Treasurer and Village Engineer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Beck Electric Company in the name of the Village;

Section 2: That the Clerk-Treasurer is authorized to refund all bonds or certified checks to the successful and unsuccessful bidders upon the execution of said contract.

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and HB 404 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.

Section 4: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and to allow for the timely engagement of Beck Electric Company in order to complete the project during good weather, and for continued operations of the Village Engineer's office and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.


