RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE SUMMIT COUNTY PUBLIC DEFENDER’S OFFICE FOR 2021 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the Summit County Public Defender’s Office for calendar year 2020. Said contract is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2: That Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and HB 197 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety of the Village residents and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Police Department, Mayor's Court, and other departments and shall therefore take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
