Ordinance No. 2020-89Passed December 2, 2020

SPONSOR: FINANCE COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND CLERK/TREASURER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO PATROLMEN'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: Full-time patrolmen and sergeants employed by the Village of Mogadore Police Department are members of the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association ("OPBA"); and,

WHEREAS: Policing services provided by these employees are governed by the terms and conditions set forth in contracts between the Village and the OPBA; and,

WHEREAS: The current Contract with these employees has undergone numerous amendments and a new Contract covering 2021 through 2023 must be approved by this Council; and,

WHEREAS: The Village, and the OPBA have negotiated a new Contract that will serve the best interests of the Village residents; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and Clerk/Treasurer are authorized and directed to enter into a contract between the OPBA and the Village of Mogadore, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and HB 197 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.

SECTION 3. Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediate and necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Mogadore, and for continuation of policing services for the Village residents, provided this legislation receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
