A RESOLUTION AMENDING SECTION 1 OF RESOLUTION 2020-3 FOR THE CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE, PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND PROVISIONS OF SUCH APPOINTMENT AND ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Todd F. Higgins, a resident of the Village of Mogadore, has been appointed as the Chief of Police of the Village of Mogadore by the Mayor effective August 10, 2013;

WHEREAS, such appointment has been approved by the Village Council in accordance with Article VII, Section 7.03 of the Mogadore Village Charter;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide a raise in salary to said position and to provide for the terms and provisions of said appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: That Section 1 of Resolution 2020-3 shall be amended to state as follows:

That effective as of January 2, 2021, the Chief of Police shall be paid an annual salary of \$81,204.22. In addition, the Chief will receive a clothing and equipment allowance of \$1,250.00. All other economic benefits contained in the current collective bargaining agreement between the Village and its Patrol Officers and Sergeants shall inure to the Chief of Police.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall be effective as of January 2, 2021.

SECTION 3: The Village of Mogadore finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements

SECTION 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and HB 197 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.
