A RESOLUTION AMENDING SECTION 1 OF RESOLUTION NO. 2019-55; ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR THE MAYOR’S COURT MAGISTRATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: That as to compensation, Resolution No. 2018-40, Section 1 is hereby amended to state as follows:

“...The compensation for the services of the Mayor’s Court Magistrate shall be an annual salary of \$6,526.43 and such amount shall be paid by the Village.”

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall be effective as of January 2, 2021.

SECTION 3: The Village of Mogadore finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and HB 197 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.

SECTION 5: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to assure the continuance of Mayor’s Court in the Village and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the residents of the Village of Mogadore and shall take effect and be in force upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
