

COUNCIL MEETING

January 6, 2021

Council met in regular session at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Rick presiding.

Ms. K. Miller asked everyone to join her in a moment of reflection for their own intentions. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all.

Due to COVID-19, the Council Meeting was moved to the Pry Community Center for safe distancing. Council members could remote into the meeting if they chose to do so. Also, the meeting was opened to the public.

Present at the community center in council chambers was Mayor Rick, Council Members: Ms. K. Miller, and Mr. M. Raddish. Ms. B. Van Dike was excused.

Present by remote was Council Members: Mr. R. McDowall, Mr. C. Yoho, and Mr. J. Tonsic, Law Director, Marshal Pitchford, Clerk-Treasurer, Scott Varney, and Village Engineer, Matthew Glass.

Motion by Mr. M. Raddish, second by Ms. K. Miller for the approval of the agenda as presented. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. M. Raddish, second by Ms. K. Miller to adopt the minutes of the December 16, 2020 Council meeting. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS FROM THE AUDIENCE ON PENDING LEGISLATION – No comments.

COMMITTEE REPORTS –

UTILITIES – Mr. Tonsic had no report.

SAFETY – No report.

PARKS – Mr. McDowall has one resolution to read.

PLANNING AND ZONING – Ms. Miller has one resolution to read.

FINANCE/AUDIT – No report due to Ms. Van Dike's absence.

STREETS – Mr. Yoho has one resolution to read.

Mr. M. Raddish announced the next Work Session will be held Wednesday, January 27, 2021 at 5:30 p.m. with all committees reporting.

OLD BUSINESS – None.

NEW BUSINESS –

Mr. M. Raddish presented Resolution 2021-1 sponsored by the Finance Committee as follows:

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2019-48 EXHIBIT "A" AND SECTION 2, PROVIDING PAY SCALE AND BENEFITS FOR VILLAGE FIRE OFFICERS AND FIREFIGHTERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. M. Raddish made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. C. Yoho seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. C. Yoho to adopt Resolution 2021-1, a second was made by Mr. M. Raddish.

Mayor Rick stated this is the two percent raise that was given to all other village employees. This includes the new supervisor pay and new night shift hourly rate for the firefighters.

Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. R. McDowall presented Resolution 2021-2 sponsored by Mayor Rick as follows:

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENTS TO THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE PARK AND RECREATION BOARD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. R. McDowall made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. M. Raddish seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. R. McDowall to adopt Resolution 2021-2; a second was made by Mr. J. Tonsic. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Ms. K. Miller presented Resolution 2021-3 sponsored by the Planning and Zoning Commission as follows:

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENTS TO THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Ms. K. Miller made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. M. Raddish seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ms. K. Miller to adopt Resolution 2021-3; a second was made by Mr. M. Raddish. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. C. Yoho presented Resolution 2021-4 sponsored by the Street Committee as follows:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE SUMMIT COUNTY SERVICE DEPARTMENT RESPONSE NETWORK TO SHARE RESOURCES AND ASSIST EACH OTHER IN THE EVENT OF EMERGENCIES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. C. Yoho made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. J. Tonsic seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. C. Yoho to adopt Resolution 2021-4; a second was made by Mr. J. Tonsic.

Mayor Rick stated with COVID the County thought we might need mutual aid for snow plowing and other auxiliary services. We already have this setup for police and fire.

Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS from the Public: Mr. Jon Mencer, 242 South Cleveland Avenue, asked how the switch from his current trash service with Republic will transition over to Kimble Recycling. Mayor Rick responded that we anticipate March 1, 2021 to be the start date, and letters will be mailed out to all residents the first week in February. Within the next few weeks, we will be sending out letters to vendors that state they will no longer be

able to provide residential service to the village. The Law Director will look into legislation that was passed last month to see what more needs to be done regarding cancelation of service with current trash haulers to see if we need to amend.

COMMENTS from Council: Mr. McDowall wished everyone safe in Washington D.C

Mr. M. Raddish wished everyone a Happy 2021 and "Go Buckeyes."


COMMENTS from the Law Director: Mr. Pitchford echoed Mr. M. Raddish and added "Go Cleveland Browns."

COMMENTS from the Mayor: Mayor Rick said he does not expect the transition to Kimble Recycling to not have hiccups. Bob Schrock asked if he canceled his trash service with his current trash hauler before March 1, 2021 could his rate be higher than the rate starting March 1, 2021 and would he receive a refund. Mayor Rick said he would look into those questions. Mayor Rick asked Council members to look at their billing cycles and let him know the dates. It might make more sense and be less complicated if we started services in April.


