AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2020-66 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Police Chief recommends the continued use of the Village's Crown Victoria for the time being; and,

WHEREAS, this Council finds it appropriate and necessary to repeal Ordinance No. 2020-66.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Village of Mogadore Ordinance No. 2020-66 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and HB 404 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Village residents, for the immediate, ongoing use of the vehicle in protection of the Village, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Police Department and other departments shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
