

COUNCIL MEETING

February 3, 2021

Council met in regular session at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Rick presiding.

Ms. B. Van Dike asked everyone to keep Deanna Harvey (council member Kathy Miller's daughter) in their prayers and to join her in a moment of reflection for their own intentions. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all.

Due to COVID-19, the Council Meeting was moved to the Pry Community Center for safe distancing. Council members could remote into the meeting if they chose to do so. Also, the meeting was opened to the public.

Present at the community center in council chambers was Mayor Rick, Council Members: Mr. M. Raddish, Ms. B. Van Dike, Ms. K. Miller, and Mr. R. Schrock.

Present by remote was Council Members: Mr. C. Yoho, Mr. R. McDowall, and Mr. J. Tonsic, Law Director, Marshal Pitchford, Clerk-Treasurer, Scott Varney, and Village Engineer, Matthew Glass.

Motion by Mr. M. Raddish, second by Mr. R. Schrock for the approval of the agenda as presented. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. M. Raddish, second by Ms. K. Miller to adopt the minutes for the January 20, 2021 Council meeting. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Ms. B. Van Dike made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. R. Schrock seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt Ordinance 2021-8; a second was made by Ms. K. Miller. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Ms. B. Van Dike presented Resolution 2021-9 sponsored by Finance Committee as follows:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFERS WITHIN FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Ms. B. Van Dike made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. R. Schrock seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt Resolution 2021-9; a second was made by Ms. K. Miller. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Ms. B. Van Dike presented Resolution 2021-10 sponsored by Finance Committee as follows:

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE VILLAGE'S INTENT TO SELL UNNEEDED, OBSOLETE OR UNFIT PERSONAL PROPERTY BY INTERNET AUCTION AND REQUIRING PUBLICATION OF THE SAME, AND, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK-TREASURER TO EXECUTE ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE A CONTRACT FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2021, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Ms. B. Van Dike made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Ms. K. Miller seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt Resolution 2021-10; a second was made by Mr. R. Schrock. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. C. Yoho presented Resolution 2021-11 sponsored by Street Committee as follows:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SELL UNNEEDED PERSONAL PROPERTY (1993 INTERNATIONAL DUMP TRUCK) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. C. Yoho made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. J. Tonsic seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. C. Yoho to adopt Resolution 2021-11; a second was made by Mr. J. Tonsic. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. R. Schrock presented Ordinance 2021-12 sponsored by Safety Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2020-66 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. R. Schrock made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Ms. K. Miller seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. R. Schrock to adopt Ordinance 2021-12; a second was made by Ms. K. Miller. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mayor Rick stated this is the Crown Victoria that Chief Higgins wanted to get rid of last year.

Ms. K. Miller presented Ordinance 2021-13 sponsored by Planning and Zoning Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE RETROACTIVELY AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTIONS 116.07(B) and (C) TO ADJUST THE ANNUAL FEE FOR SKILLED GAMING LOCATIONS FOR 2021 AND THE REMAINING FEES FOR SKILLED GAMING FACILITIES FOR A PERIOD OF SIX MONTHS, AND ALLOWING MONTHLY PAYMENTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Ms. K. Miller made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Ms. B. Van Dike seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ms. K. Miller to adopt Ordinance 2021-13; a second was made by Ms. B. Van Dike. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS from Council: Ms. Miller thanked Council for their prayer for her daughter's transplant tomorrow. Mr. Raddish asked everyone to keep the Tompkins's family in their thoughts and prayers on the passing of Robert Tompkins Jr.. He was well known in the community and he will be missed.

COMMENTS from the Village Engineer: No comments.


